What is TEPP?

TEPP helps people with disabilities buy phone equipment that makes communicating easier! TEPP helps cover the cost of a many different devices, such as: teletypewriters (TTY), amplified phones, headsets, and more!

How Does it Work?

TEPP is a voucher program. It requires a person to pay the first \$100 of the equipment. TEPP then covers the rest of the cost.

What is TAP?

If an individual cannot afford the first \$100 of cost, the TAP program can assist. An individual will need to answer a few more questions to receive this extra help.

Who is Eligible?

Wisconsin residents with deafness, hearing impairment, speech impairment, mobility, and motion impairment.

TEPP is available to individuals regardless of age or income!

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How Do You Apply?

Apply for TEPP & TAP at the same time! When you fill out your TEPP application, fill out the income section too. Also provide a hearing loss certificate, if applicable.

After you apply, if found eligible you will receive a voucher in the mail. This may take up to several weeks.

Take your voucher to a TEPP vendor and buy your equipment. Be sure to use the voucher within 120 days or it will expire.

How Much Can You Save?

TEPP recipients will pay the first \$100 of their equipment. The voucher amount is determined by the severity of an individual's disability.

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
