What is Lifeline?

Lifeline is a federal program that provides discounted phone and internet services for low income households.

Who Is Eligible?

You are eligible for Lifeline if you receive health coverage from Medicaid, food benefits from FoodShare, income from Social Security, and more.

You can also be eligible if your income is 135% or less of the federal poverty level (example: \$1,436/per month for a family size of 1).

How Can I Apply?

You can apply right now on this website: www.checklifeline.org. You can also apply by phone or mail. If you are eligible, you will be directed with next steps on how to start your services.
