

# BadgerCare Plus Enrollment for Kids

## Did You Know...

**There is free or low-cost health care coverage available** to Wisconsin children, individuals, and families! BadgerCare Plus may pay for:

Doctor Visits

Hospital Care

Checkups

Prescriptions

And more!

Generally, children under age 19, parents, and adults may be eligible if they meet income and a few other guidelines!

## For kids, consider the following questions:

**If you answered "YES" to all of these—you're on your way.**

Is the child under age 19?

Is the child in Wisconsin and intends to stay?

Is the child a citizen or legal permanent resident?

Is the household below 306% of Federal Poverty Level?

Keep in mind there may be exceptions and other questions to answer, like on access to a parent's work insurance that might limit or expand eligibility for this program.


