TEPP & TAP PROGRAMS

What is TEPP?

The Telecommunications Equipment Purchase Program (TEPP) helps people with disabilities pay for telephone equipment.

The assistance comes in the form of a voucher. This voucher's amount is based on an applicant's disability.

You are required to pay a copay of \$100 unless you have a hearing impairment and qualify for TAP. Income and other eligibility rules apply: https://www.dhs.wisconsin.gov/odhh/tap.htm

Who Is Eligible for TEPP?

Wisconsin residents with: deafness, hearing impairment, speech impairment, mobility, and motion impairment are eligible for TEPP. Income and age do not affect eligibility.
